DISCHARGE CONSENT ORDER

With reference to the application no. 4249277 dated 16.12.2020 of M/s Sangam Mediserve Pvt. Ltd., for consent under section 25/26 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, are granted consent to operate for a Common Bio Medical Waste Treatment Facility of IGIMS, Patna at Village- Jakariyapur (Ramchak Bairiya), Tahsil- Patna, Dist.-Patna. This Consent Order will be valid for the period of five years from the date of issue or till the validity of agreement with IGIMS, Patna whichever is earlier with the following conditions: -

That, they shall not make any alteration, addition, deletion or modification in the plant/hospital without the prior clearance from the Board and shall also abide by the obligations under sections 24,31 and 33A of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and further shall extend co-operation to the Board in performing its functions entrusted under sections 20,21,23,30 and 32 of the Act;

That, they shall comply with the requirements of the Environment (Protection) Act, 2. 1986; the Hazardous Waste Management Rules 2016; the Manufacture, Storage and Import of Hazardous Chemical Rules, 1989, and the provisions of the Public Liability Insurance Act, 1991, whichever is applicable:

That, they shall monitor their effluents (s) regularly and maintain its quality in 3. conformity with Board's standards and shall produce its proof, as and when asked

That, they shall submit application for consent again 30 days before the expiration of 4. the period of consent;

That, the occupier shall submit effluent test report from the approved laboratory every six month during the consent period and it should conform the permissible limit of the CPCB;

That, the unit shall submit Environmental Statement by Sept. every year; 6.

That, the bio-degradable waste shall be processed, treated and disposed off through compositing or bio-methanation within the premises as far as possible. The residual waste shall be given to the waste collectors or agency as directed by the local body;

That, the Operator shall comply all the provisions of the Bio-medical Waste 8.

Management Rules, 2016.

9. That, they will ensure regular operation of OCEMS system with proper connectivity with CPCB and SPCB servers.

- 10. That, the operator shall ensure to follow guidelines of Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment and Disposal Facilities issued by CPCB, as amended time to
- 11. That, this consent order is granted, subject to the condition that in the event of any information's/ documents submitted by the proponent are found false or misleading at any stage the consent order granted shall be revoked and legal action shall be initiated;

12. That, The unit shall comply with all above conditions and submit compliance report every year to the Board;
