EMISSION CONSENT ORDER

With reference to the application no. 4249277 dated 16.12.2020 of **M/s Sangam Mediserve Pvt. Ltd.**, under section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, are granted consent to operate for a Common Bio Medical Waste Treatment Facility of IGIMS, Patna at Village- Jakariyapur (Ramchak Bairiya), Tahsil- Patna, Dist.- Patna. This Consent Order will be valid for the period of five years from the date of issue or till the validity of agreement with IGIMS, Patna whichever is earlier with the following conditions: -

1. That, they shall not make any alteration, addition, deletion or modification in the plant without the prior clearance from the Board and shall also abide by the obligations under sections 22,23 and 31A of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and further shall extend co-operation to the Board in performing its functions entrusted under sections 24,25 and 26 of the Act;
2. That, they shall comply with the requirements of the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986; the Hazardous Waste Management Rules, 2016; the Manufacture, Storage and Import of Hazardous Chemical Rules, 1989; and the provisions of the Public Liability Insurance Act, 1991, whichever is applicable;
3. That, they shall monitor his/their emission(s) and the ambient air quality from representative point regularly and shall maintain its quality in conformity with Board's standards and shall produce its proof, as and when asked for;
4. That, they shall submit application for consent again 30 days before the expiration of the period of consent.
5. That, the occupier shall submit stack emission report every six month during the period of consent order.
6. That, the D.G set should be provided with an integral acoustic enclosure and the maximum permissible sound pressure level for new D.G set shall be 75dB(A) at 1 meter from the enclosure surface.
7. That, the minimum height of stack for exhaust emission to be provided with D.G set shall be 1.0 meter more than the height of the building where it is installed.
8. That, the unit shall maintain Online Stack Emission Monitoring System.
9. That, the unit shall submit Environmental Statement by Sept. every year;
10. That, tree plantation shall be done in space available in the complex;
11. That, the operator shall comply all the conditions as imposed in the Authorisation under the Bio-medical Waste Management Rules, 2016
12. That, the unit shall submit Annual Report in Form -IV under the Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016 to the Board within 30th June every year;
13. That, they will ensure regular operation of OCEMS system with proper connectivity with CPCB and SPCB servers.
14. That, the operator shall ensure to follow guidelines of Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment and Disposal Facilities issued by CPCB, as amended time to time.
15. That, this consent order is granted, subject to the condition that in the event of any information's/ documents submitted by the proponent are found false or misleading at any stage the consent order granted shall be revoked and legal action shall be initiated;
16. The unit shall comply with all above conditions and submit compliance report every year to the Board.
