OFFICE ORDER

Consequent upon the approval of competent authority, in the light of present NMC guidelines laid down in GMER 2019, following eligibility criteria are hereby fixed for MBBS students of IGIMS of batch 2019 and subsequent years for their appearance in Professional **Examinations:**

A. Attendance

- 1. 75% attendance in theory and 80% attendance in practical/clinical is required to be eligible to appear in the examinations of a subject. In subjects that are taught in more than one phase, the learner must have 75% attendance in theory and 80% in practical in each phase of instruction in that subject.
- 2. If an examination comprises more than one subject (for example General Surgery and allied branches), the candidate must have 75% attendance in each subject and 80% attendance in each clinical posting.
- 3. Learners, who do not have at least 75% attendance in the electives, will not be eligible for the Third Professional - Part II Examination.

B. Performance

Learners must secure at least 50% marks of the total marks (combined in theory and practical/clinical; not less than 40% marks in theory and practical separately) assigned for internal assessment in a particular subject in order to be eligible for appearing in the final university examination of that subject. Internal assessment marks will reflect as separate head of passing at the summative examination.

As per the erstwhile MCI-BOG guidelines laid down in GMER 2018, the eligibility criteria of MBBS students admitted before 2019 are as follows:

A. Attendance

75% attendance in a subject for appearing in the examination is compulsory inclusive of attendance in non-lecture teaching, i.e., seminars, group discussions, tutorials, demonstrations, practical, hospital (Tertiary, Secondary, Primary) posting and bed side clinics, etc.

B. Performance

Student must secure at least 35% marks of the total marks fixed for internal assessment in a particular subject in order to be eligible to appear in final university examination of that subject.
