4. Earnest Money of Rs. 2, 00, 000/-(Rs. Two Lakh Only) only is required to be submitted along with tender by Demand Draft only along with the tender favoring Director, I.G.I.M.S. – Patna (payable at Patna). No interest is payable on EMD/ Bid security.
5. Non- submission of EMD along with the Technical Bid shall be one of the primary reasons for rejection of the offer in the first round.
6. Supplied equipment must be US FDA Certified. All the necessary equipment will be provided by the tenderer and in future the responsibility of any software or hardware upgrade will lie solely on the tenderer. Details of equipment to be provided by tenderer must be mentioned.
7. All reagents & consumables must be US FDA registered or having free sale certificate from European Countries.
8. The entire laboratory operation, all equipments & availability of reagents / consumables shall be guaranteed for an up time of 98% reckoned every calendar month including holidays & penalty shall be levied in case of uptime is less than 98% in any month.
9. The firm will be responsible for compliance of all rules & regulations including lab accreditation.
10. The Institute shall pay for the reagents only on mutually agreed prices. The Institute shall provide space (which may be inspected before submission of Tender) electrical outlets & water points as existing for the area, free of cost. Additional electricity supply as required shall be provided at one point free of cost.
11. The Institute shall enter into a service contract for tests on cost of reagent only for minimum period of five years which may be extendable for another three years depending on the performance.
12. The firm should have minimum annual turnover of twenty five crores (Rs. 25crores) in each of the financial years i.e. 2013-14, 2014-15 & 2016-17.

13. Tenderer must have **at least three agreements executed for 24 hour labs services running** at Govt. Hospitals or Govt. Medical College(s) or Medical Teaching Institutes. MOU along with performance report need to be submitted.

**CHAPTER – 2**

**CONDITIONS OF THE CONTRACT**

## CONDITIONS OF THE CONTRACT

1. **Destination of Delivery:** Central Store Section, I.G.I.M.S., Sheikhpura , Patna
2. **Acknowledgement and Discrepancies :**  
On receipt of the supply orders any discrepancies should be pointed out within 10 days of the issue of the order. In case, no intimation to the contrary is received from the firm within 10 days, it will be assumed that order has been accepted in full even though it may have been placed after the lapse of the validity period of the quotation.
3. **Prices:** As mention in supply orders.
4. **Taxes:** Inclusive / Exclusive .If taxes are extra please specifying the rate of tax applicable on the items.
5. **Payment:-** After receipt of goods and submission of satisfactory Inspection Report issued by officials as authorized by the competent authority.
6. **Price Variation Clause:** The institute shall accept the price rates as mentioned in the quotation only. The claim for price increase over the quoted price shall not be accepted by the institute within the validity period of the quotation (one year).
7. **Validity of Price:** One Year from the date of opening of Price Bid. Review after one year in view of Price Index / Market Rate (On Mutual Agreement).
8. IGIMS will only provide the space, water & electricity and tenderer has to establish the complete lab including analyzers and other necessary equipment at his own cost and maintain them.
9. **Delivery Period: 30** days from the date of issuance of supply order. However, shorter delivery period will be preferred.
10. **Penalty Clause:** If the functioning of lab suffers due to any reason resulting in delay in reporting a penalty of Rs 1000 (One thousand only) per day will be charged from the vendor. Further tenderer has to make alternative arrangement for processing of Emergency Samples or otherwise Emergency sample will be processed from any other approved lab by IGIMS and the charges will be deducted from the payment of tenderer.
11. **Payment:** Payment will normally be made when the full supplies is made against a supply order, except when part supply has been allowed in supply order or when supplier has been asked to supply in installment. Or in any other special circumstance by order of competent authority. In such a situation payment may be released upon part supply after completing established procedures
12. **Replacement of defective / expired supplies:** Shall be the responsibility of the firm on their cost, who has executed the supply.
13. **Expiry date of item supplied:** No supply of items having expiry date less than 50% on the date of supply shall be accepted by the Institute.
15. **Discrepancy or Omission:**  
The payments are made strictly on the basis of the supply order and firms are advised not to deviate from supply orders instruction in all respect. In the event of there being any discrepancy, the matter should first be referred to the institute for necessary amendment in the supply order before making actual supply and submission of the bill.
16. **Challan:**  
The suppliers should submit the challan in triplicate alongwith the supplies to the Central Store, IGIMS, Patna-14.

17. The bills should be submitted to the office of the Officer under whose signature supply order has been issued.

**18 Items available in different packing, size/quantities:**

For the items available in different packing sizes/quantities the gross rate as well as unit price (In terms of relevant net quantity) should be mentioned for each packing size/quantity.

- 19 Supplier is required to give under taking to the effect that they have not supplied the Items quoted to any Govt./ Semi Govt. institution / organization at prices lower than the price being quoted. Further, in case of price going down in future, it will pass on the benefit to IGIMS, Patna.
- 20 Tenderer must submit a certificate that the quoted price is not higher than the MRP or market price of the same make of the quoted items.
- 21 **Replacement:** Replacement of defective supplies shall be the responsibility of supplier at their own cost.
- 22 If manufacturer shall submit their quotation directly and authorizes any local agent / distributor to supply and raise the invoice for payment on the rates quoted by them, after approval of the rate/quotation by the competent authority of the institute, their authorized agent/ distributors can supply the items and raise the bill for payment. However, responsibility shall be of manufacturer. A proper authorization certificate in favour of local agent / distributors is to be submitted by the manufacturer along with their bid.

**IMPORTANT**

The procedures for rendering of bills are prescribed in clauses above. It is essential that the bills should be in accordance with these clauses: -

1. The bills should be prepared in triplicate.
2. It should be accompanied by the Inspection Note to be obtained from the department concerned of the Institute.
3. The Bills should be pre-receipted and affixed with Revenue stamps, where necessary.
4. In bills B.S.T. / VAT registration number must be mentioned on each copy of the bill.
5. The bills should be supported by a certificate for Excise Duty as stated in the above clause.
