4. Bidder desiring to participate in the tender shall have to get registered with e-procurement. Necessary registration forms are available at the website. Bidder will get user id and password by registration. Bidder shall have to obtain DSC (Digital Signature Certificates) also. 11. MINIMUM CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY FOR TECHNICAL QUALIFICATION (TECHNICAL BID SHALL CONTAIN)

Experience Certificate/Completion Certificate

The contracting Firm/Agency should have satisfactorily completed as a Prime contractor in Civil work mentioned in Serial No-1 and Prime contractor during the **last five years** ending of October 2023. The Similar nature of work value of previous years will be adjusted to 2023-24 price level based on annual inflation of 10% (Ten percent) on compound basis.

Three works of similar nature each costing not less than 40% (forty percent) of the estimated cost.

“Or”

Two works of similar nature each costing not less than 50% (Fifty percent) of the estimated cost.

“Or”

One work of similar nature costing not less than 80% (eighty percent) of the estimated cost

“Similar Work” shall means:

For the work Serial No-01, Bidder must have experience in RCC foundation, column, and Roof slab including internal electrical and plumbing work.

Note: The experience certificate should be certified by an officer not below the rank of Engineer in-charge or equivalent and supported by TDS certificate.

TURN OVER

The contracting Firm/Agency should have achieved during last **Five Years** in any one year a minimum annual financial turnover [in all classes of Civil Engineering Construction works and Electrical Engineering Construction works for the separate works mentioned in serial no-01 and 02] of at least **50% (fifty percent) of the estimated cost of work**, ending on 31st March 2023. The annual turnover of previous years will be adjusted to 2022-23 price level based on annual inflation of 8% (eight percent) for a year on simple interest basis. Certificate from statutory auditor is required to verify the turnover from Civil engineering Construction works.

PROFIT & LOSS

Should not have incurred any loss in more than two years during the immediate last five consecutive financial years ending 31.3 2023. The statement should be duly certified by the chartered accountant. Submit the audited Profit & Loss Account to verify the same.

SOLVENCY

The Firm / Agency have to produce Bankers Solvency Certificate (Not more than 3 months old from the date of publication of tender). Or Revenue Solvency Certificate of Value not less than 25% of the estimated cost of the project.

BIDING CAPACITY

The bidding capacity of the contractor should be equal to or more than the cost of the work. The bidding capacity shall be worked out by the following formula: -

Bidding capacity = (A x N x 3-B).

Where,

A= Maximum value of construction works executed in any one year during the last five years (updated to the price level of the year 2022-23) taking into account the completed as well as works in progress. Work in progress value must be certified by Statutory Auditor or any Chartered Accountant.

N= Numbers of years prescribed for completion of work for which Tender bid has been invited.

B= Value of existing commitments and ongoing works to be completed during the period of completion of work for which Technical – Qualification has been invited.

Note: - The statements showing the value of existing commitments and on-going works as well as the stipulated period of completion remaining for each of the works listed should be countersigned by the Engineer in charge, not below the rank of an Engineer-in-charge or equivalent.

Note:- FOR WORK SI. No. -01 Bidders will submit the vetted () design, details drawing plan elevation according to BOQ specification and annexure-1(Drawing Plan /Layout approved by EIC) along with RCC and Steel structure drawings Vetted from IIT/NIT) if the work is awarded to him on his own cost.

OTHER QUALIFICATION CRITERIA (TECHNICAL BID SHALL CONTAIN)

- (A) The Firm/Agency should be a well established and reputed firm/agency specialized in the trade and registered as a legal entity. The Firm/Agency should be operational for a minimum period of **Ten years** and having experience and capacity in the execution of similar nature of works. Documents related to constitution of the firm/agency should be submitted to establish the same.
- (B) Notarize copy of experienced firms registered in appropriate class under CPWD, BCD, Energy Department, PESU, Railway or in any government organization under which similar nature of work has been carried. Bidder must be Prime Contractor for the work mentioned in serial no-01 & 02.
- (C) The firm / Agency should produce evidence of access to lines of credit and availability of other financial resources facilities (10% of contract value), certified by the Bankers in specified format uploaded with bid documents.
- (D) Undertaking on appropriate value of Non Judicial stamp before 1st class magistrate regarding investing minimum cash up to 25% of contract values of project, during implementation of work. (in Prescribed format).
- (E) Submit the Copies of the Audited Balance Sheet and Profit and Loss Account including Auditor's Report for the last five financial years i.e., 2018-19, 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23. Audited and certified by Chartered Accountant.
- (F) Submit the copy of valid GST, EPF, ESIC registration with up to date challan and copy of Pan Card.
- (G) An affidavit before first class Magistrate of Rs. 1000 (Non-judicial stamp) stating that "In case any ambiguity is noticed in the documents submitted at any stage, we shall be entirely responsible and liable for any action as deemed fit under the law" shall be submitted by the Firm/Agency with Technical – Qualification Document.
- (H) Submit power of attorney, notarized resolution of board etc. for authorizing to sign and submit prequalification

documents with duly signed by the Authorized signatory of the Firm/Agency as applicable.

- (I) Bank Defaulter: Submit an Affidavit on Rs 1000 Non judicial stamp before the 1st class Magistrate confirming that Bidder is not defaulter from any Bank.
- (J) PLANTS / MACHINERY and Equipment: Documents showing ownership or leased document for having PLANTS / MACHINERY and equipment required as per list given in GCC Volume -I for separate works in which the bidder is participated.
- (K) Affidavit on Rs 1000 Non Judicial stamp before 1st class Magistrate regarding black listed, debar or rescind of their work on the format annex with the Bid.
- (L) Notarize copy of Valid Electrical Contractor License (Above 440 Volt) working in HT line in the name of the bidder issued from the competent government licensing authority for the work serial no-02.
- (M) Manpower: The bidder must show the proof of availability of key personal as per list given in GCC Volume -1

(N) Even though the bidders meet the above qualifying criteria, they are subject to be disqualified if They have:

- made misleading or false representations in the forms, statements and attachments submitted in proof of the qualification requirements; and/or
-
- have record of poor performance such as abandoning the works, not properly completing the contract, inordinate delays in completion, litigation history, or financial failures etc; and/or
- Participated in the previous bidding for the same work and had quoted unreasonably high or low bid prices and could not furnish rational justification to the employer.

(O) Bidders has to submit an affidavit for submitted experience certificate (as required in para 7.1 of eligible criteria) that the Work has been completed without penalty imposed by Client.

JOINT VENTURE – Not Allowed.

- (P) Must show bankers certificate for having Liquid assets and/or availability of credit facilities not less than 10% of the tendered value.
- (Q) The near relations (defined as first blood relations, and their spouses, of the bidder or the bidder's spouse) of persons. The bidder must produce an affidavit before first class magistrate stating that the near relations of the following departmental officers are not in his employment:
- (R) JE/AE/EE/SE/CE/E-in-C & Divisional Accountant of any works department of IGIMS, Patna.
- (S) Without Government permission, any person who retired as gazetted officer within the last two years of the rank and from the IGIMS, Patna. The bidder must produce an affidavit before first class Magistrate stating the names of retired gazetted officer (if any) in his employment who retired within the last two years. With the following ranks from the departments listed below:
- (T) JE/AE/EE/SE/CE/E-in-C & Divisional Accountant of any works department of Bihar State.
- (U) In case there is no such person in the employment, his affidavit should clearly states this fact.
- (V) The Bidder must submit an affidavit before first class magistrate /Executive magistrate that they are not having litigation history during last five years.
- (W) The term first class Magistrate means executive Magistrate also for the same purpose
- (X) Note:- Additional Performance security cost will be submitted by the bidder for Serious Unbalance Rate as per notification no 447/(5) dated 16/01/2020 of Road Construction Deptt. Govt. Of Bihar.

Note: In case of absence of any above mentioned Certificate, the Bid is liable to be rejected.

INSTRUCTION TO TENDERER

1. IGIMS reserves the right to accept or reject any application without assigning any reason or incurring any liability whatsoever.
2. Bidders are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their tenders on his own cost, to acquaint themselves from the nature of the work and nature of the ground and sub-soil, the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the volume of work involved, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their work tender. The bidder shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site, nature of work etc., whether he inspects it or not. It is to note that and no extra charges for complete work either in civil electrical or mechanical work, etc. will be paid to the contractor. Any misunderstanding or otherwise shall not be allowed.
3. The work to be awarded by this tender shall be treated as indivisible works contract for separate works in which bidder is participated.
4. IGIMS reserves the right to inspect the works intimated to have been completed by the applicant and reject any prospective application without assigning any reason.
5. The tender for the works shall remain open for acceptance for a period of 120 days from the date of opening of tenders.
6. **Completion period**
The completion period indicated in the tender documents is for the entire work of planning, designing, supplying, installation, testing, commission and handing over of the entire job to the satisfaction of the Engineer - in - charge.
7. **Warranty**
All the items covered in the BOQ, shall carry minimum Thirty six months Onsite Comprehensive Warranty, commencing from the date of completion of entire job. The after sales service support / warranty services have to be provided at IGIMS, Patna-14. The repairing / rectification/ replacement of any items under warranty must be done at site only within 24 hours.
8. The bidder should submit along with the technical bid, the detailed plan for providing installation and warranty services at site. Prompt and efficient after sales service must be free within the warranty period.
9. The bidders name, date, signature & seal should appear on each page of the Tender Documents which are required to be submitted with technical bid in the form of hard copy.
10. The bidder shall be responsible for the delivery of the material/ equipment to site and shall include in his bid all the necessary arrangements for transport, loading and off-loading (including cranes, lifting tackles, wire rope, winches, slings, etc. All the necessary arrangement along with material for installation, testing and commissioning to complete the work will be contractor's responsibility. IGIMS will not accept any claims for additional costs in this regard.
11. If the contractor or his workmen or employees shall break, deface, injure, or destroy any part of a building, road kerb, fence, enclosure, water pipes, cables, drains, electric or telephone posts, wires, etc. The contractor shall make the same good at his own expenses. IGIMS may cause the same to be made good by other workmen and deduct the expenses of which IGIMS decision is final.
12. **Safety**
The successful bidder shall follow the Safety Code and Model Rules for the Protection of health and sanitary arrangement for Workers.
13. The quality of all the materials to be utilized by the successful bidder must be get approved by the Engineer-in-charge before utilizing it.
14. The successful bidder has to submit daily progress report and submit the measurement of the work to the Engineer- in-charge while execution of the work.
15. This Notice Inviting Tender (NIT) shall form a part of the contract document. The successful bidder/contractor, on acceptance of his tender by the Accepting Authority, shall, sign the contract agreement within 15 days from the stipulated date of start of the work.
16. The contractor shall submit the program for execution of work, get it approved from the Engineer In-charge and strictly adhere the same for the timely completion of the project work before start of the work.
17. The rate for all items of work shall include the cost of all labor, materials and all other inputs involved in the execution of the complete work and nothing extra on any account will be paid to the agency other than his quoted rates.

18. While installing or commissioning the contractor or his authorized representative should always be available at the site of work to take instructions from department officers and ensure proper execution of work.
19. The contractor shall maintain in good condition all work executed till the completion of entire work allotted to the contractor. No payment will be made to the contractor for damages caused by rains, floods or any other natural calamity, whatsoever during the execution of the work. The contractor shall be fully responsible for any damage to the Owners property and to the work for which the payment has been advanced to him under the contract during the execution of the works.
20. The malba /garbage, removed from the site shall be disposed off by the contractor at any suitable place as directed by the Engineer-In-Charge.
21. Material must be properly packed against any damage and insured up to the destination. The material should be directly dispatched to the installation site at IGIMS, Patna -14.
22. All the expenses involved in delivering, unloading etc. the equipment at our site, shall be borne by the Bidder. All aspects of safe delivery shall be the exclusive responsibility of the Bidder. IGIMS will have the right to reject the component/equipment supplied, if it does not comply with the specifications at any point of installation, inspection and testing. EMD is liable to be forfeited and bid is liable to be rejected, if the bidder withdraws or amends impairs or derogates from the tender in any respect within the validity period of the tender.
23. If any equipment/material or part thereof is lost or rendered defective during transit, the supplier shall immediately arrange for the replacement of damaged equipment or part thereof, as the case may be, at no extra cost.
24. Rates should be quoted towards Supply at site, Unloading, Erection, Commissioning, Testing and Maintenance of Supplies / Materials given under BOQ, accordingly by giving the basic price, GST, Service Tax, etc. wherever applicable.
25. Along with slandered deduction, 1% labour cess will be deducted of the completed work as per prevailing Bihar state government rules.
26. IGIMS shall have the sole right to assess the performance of the tendered equipment(s) /components, primary / intermediate and or final, and reject the same without assigning any reason / explanation to the bidder if the performance is found to be unsatisfactory. The decision of IGIMS will be final and binding on the contractor.
27. Price basis should be FOR IGIMS Patna only. The quoted price will be considered firm and no price escalation will be permitted.

28. SECURITY DEPOSIT

The amount of Security Money shall be 10% (Ten Percent) of the work order Value- and deduction/deposit shall be made in following manner.

Earnest money to the tender may be submitted through bank guarantee / internet payment Gateway/ Internet Banking Earnest money deposit and Initial Security Deposit of (Five Percent) of the accepted/agreed value, which has to be deposited by the contractor through/ through bank guarantee / internet payment Gateway/ Internet Banking/ and remain with IGIMS till expiry of warranty period and Defect liability period (DLP)

- a) Balance 5% (Five Percent) Security Money shall be deducted from each running account bill of work done under this work order.
29. Security deposit shall be refunded after expiry of warranty period which shall carry twelve months Onsite Comprehensive Warranty, commencing from the date of completion of entire job provided there are no defects in this work and removed all surplus material, rubbish from site. The Security deposit shall be totally non-interest bearing and the bank guarantee, if furnished, shall also not entail any liability towards bank interest, money or bank charges etc. on IGIMS.

30. Payment

The Final payment will be released after satisfactory completion of entire works as per agreement through Measurement book. All the payment shall be made on actual measurement basis. A running account bill on the request may be released after actual measurement.

The successful bidder, on signing an indenture in the form to be specified by the Engineer-in-charge shall be entitled to be paid, during the execution of work, up to 70% of the estimated value of any materials, which, in the opinion of the Engineer-in-charge-, are non-perishable and which have been procured and adequately stored against damage, but which have not been incorporated in the works at the time of making advance. This secured advance shall be subject to the following:

The materials are in accordance with the specification for works;

Such materials have been delivered to site, and are properly stored and protected against damage or deterioration to the satisfaction of the Engineer-in-charge. The Contractor shall store the bulk material in measurable stacks;

The Contractor's records of the requirements, orders, receipt and use of materials are kept in a form approved by the Executive Engineer Electrical and such records shall be available for inspection by the Engineer-in-charge.

The Contractor has submitted with his monthly statement the estimated value of the materials on site together with such documents as may be required by the Engineer-in-charge- for the purpose of valuation of the materials and providing evidence of ownership and payment thereof;

Ownership of such materials shall be deemed to vest in the Employer for which the Contractor has submitted an Indemnity Bond in an acceptable format;

The quantities of materials are not excessive and shall be used within a reasonable time as determined by the Engineer-in-charge.

31. Compensation for Delayed Services

In the event of the contractor failing to complete the works within the completion period (allotted time) shown against the each work in the tender and which starts from the day of handing over the written order to the contractor he shall be liable to pay as compensation an amount equal to 0.5% on the amount of the agreed cost of the whole work per day that the due quantity work remains incomplete provided that the entire amount of compensation to be paid under this provisions of this clause shall not exceed 10% of total order value for the work.

32. The contractor shall clear the site thoroughly of all scaffolding materials and rubbish etc. left out of his work and dress the site around the building to the satisfaction of the Engineer before the work is considered as complete.
33. The quoted rate shall be complete in all respects including the cost of all materials, labour, tools & plants, machinery etc. IGIMS shall not be supplying any material, labour, plant etc.
34. The contractor has to ensure co-ordination with Institute authorities to maintain the smooth functioning / operation of existing Institute timing without disruption during the execution of work. This may require working rescheduling the normal working hours, working in restricted period etc. Nothing extra shall be payable on this account.
35. Stacking of materials and excavated earth including its disposal shall be done as per the directions of the Electrical Executive Engineer. Double handling of materials or excavated earth if required shall have to be done by the contractor at his own cost.
36. In the case of any tender where unit rate of any item/ items appear unrealistic, such tender will be considered as unbalanced and in case the bidder is unable to provide satisfactory explanation such a tender is liable to be disqualified and rejected.
37. On account of security consideration, some restrictions may be imposed by the security staff on the working and movement of men and materials etc. The contractor shall be bound to follow all such restrictions/ instructions and he shall organize his work accordingly. No claim on this account, whatsoever, shall be payable.
38. The contractor shall be responsible for completing the work and for satisfying all terms and conditions of the Contract without any extra payment over his quoted rates unless otherwise specified.
