NOTICE INVITING TENDER (No.: 09 / IGIMS / 18)

TENDER FORM FOR OPERATING CAFETERIA ON LICENSE BASIS AT INDIRA GANDHI INSTITUTE OF MEDICAL SCIENCES

Description of the Tender

Operating cafeteria on license basis for a period of thirty (30) months in the campus of Indira Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Sheikhpura, Bailey Road, Patna, Bihar, PIN – 800014.

It is proposed to have a cafeteria which showcases the best of cuisines (traditional / Chinese / continental), with a contemporary interpretation understanding their nutritive values and, where appropriate, giving them a twist to make them healthier or more delicious.. High standards of hygiene, presentation and services are expected.

2. The entire documents should be duly filled in and submitted in original.
3. All pages should be signed by the Applicant under seal.
4. All information to be written legibly. Where figures are furnished, these are to be written in words also, within brackets.
5. Attach separate sheets wherever necessary.

1. Key Terms:

Following words and terms used in this document shall, unless the context requires otherwise, have the following meaning:

- a) ‘Tender’ or ‘Bid’ means the formal offer to undertake the work.
- b) “IGIMS” means Indira Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences.
- c) ‘Applicant’ or ‘Tenderer’ or ‘Bidder’ means the person submitting the Tender pursuant to the Notice Inviting Tender.
- d) ‘Cafeteria’ means the cafeteria at IGIMS Campus, near “Dhanwantri Hostel”.
- e) ‘Chairman’ is the Medical Superintendent (regular) of IGIMS.

f) "License Agreement" means the agreement to be executed between the Licensee and IGIMS for award of license to the Licensee to operate the Cafeteria.

g) "Licensee" or "Agency" means the individual/agency selected for award of license to operate the Cafeteria.

h) "Licensed Premises" means the Cafeteria building situated in the IGIMS Campus behind the new library and by side of "Dhanwantri Hostel" measuring 432 sqmtr.

i) 'Licensor' means IGIMS .

j) "Term" means the term commencing from the Commencement Date, until the termination of the license awarded to the Licensee to operate the Cafeteria.

2. Terms and Conditions:

I. Terms and Conditions for submission of the tender

- No Tenderer shall be a close relative of any employee of IGIMS, nor shall any Tenderer be associated with an employee of IGIMS or their close relatives as proprietor / partner / share holder / director and the like.

- The successful Tenderer shall be required to enter into a License Agreement with IGIMS, governing the Terms and Conditions of the license on non-judicial stamp paper

- The Tender should accompany a demand draft of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) in favour of Director IGIMS, drawn on the State Bank of India or any other nationalized bank towards Earnest Money Deposit which shall be refunded to unsuccessful Tenderer for which no interest shall be payable.

- The successful Tenderer shall submit the following documents within 7 days from the date of placement of the work order:

- Duplicate copy of the work order duly signed by the Tenderer as a token of acceptance of the service contract.

- Original copy of the License Agreement/deed of license governing the Terms and Conditions of the Contract on non-judicial stamp paper

- The Cafeteria shall be kept open on all days of the year during the prescribed hours of functioning from 6.30 A.M. to 10.30 P.M. only. No order should be entertained after 10 pm.

II. Rent:

The rent of the entire cafeteria premises including the ground & first floor of the building and the parking lot is fixed at ₹ 35000/(Thirty five thousand) per month for first one year and revised later on 10 % enhancement as per rule, excluding the electricity charge which will be borne by the Licensee separately on the basis of consumption to be read with a sub-meter

installed. All amount have to be deposited before 7th of every month to the Director, IGIMS, Patna.

III Eligibility:

An Applicant shall be an individual/firm/agency of sound financial status having a minimum two years' experience in running a cafeteria or restaurant in a reputed Institution or serving as caterer for more than 500 people at a time at frequent occasions.

- An Applicant shall submit, directly or indirectly, only one application in the tendering process, either individually as an applicant or as a partner. An Applicant who submits or participates in more than one application will cause all the applications in which the Applicant has participated to be disqualified.
- The Applicant should not be barred or black-listed by any Government Department
- Applicants and all parties constituting the Applicant shall provide such evidence of their continued eligibility as required.
- Valid Food Safety and Standards Licence from FSSAI.
- Valid Trade License and GST Registration certificate should be possessed by the Applicant.

IV Pre-Bid Conference:

- The Tender should be accompanied by Earnest Money Deposit of Rs. 50,000/- in the form of demand draft.
- Tenders not accompanied by Earnest Money Deposit are liable to be summarily rejected.
- Earnest Money Deposit of unsuccessful Applicants will be returned without interest after the finalization of the tender.

VI. Submission of Tender Form

VII. Tender form should be filled up in all respects and returned by the Applicant duly signed on each page of the original Tender form including the pages containing the terms and conditions and should be properly sealed. **The following documents must accompany the Tender Form.**

- Certificate of furnishing correct information: The Applicant shall furnish a certificate to the effect that correct information has been furnished in the Tender and the Applicant shall be solely responsible for furnishing misleading, wrong or false information in the Tender. Furnishing of misleading, wrong or false information may lead to the cancellation of the Bid.

- A certificate of sound financial status from a nationalised bank with whom the bidder has financial transactions.
- A letter of authorization duly authorizing the signatory to participate and sign the Tender documents on the letterhead of the Applicant.
- A declaration on non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 100/- duly attested by Notary Public to the effect that the Applicant is not barred or black-listed any Government Department or Public Sector Undertaking
- Copies of financial statement (balance sheets, including all related notes, and income statements) for the last 3 financial years.
- **A sample menu with quoted price of Indian, Chinese and Continental Snacks, Lunch, Dinner items. (SAMPLE MENU PROVIDED AS ANNEXURE-3 SHOULD BE SUBMITTED DULLY FILLED IN. BIDDER CAN ADD MORE ITEMS WITH QUOTED PRICE BUT CAN NOT DELETE ANY OF THE ITEMS FROM THE LIST) . The quantity of each item (as applicable) should be expressed in either gram or ml.**
- **A sample menu with quoted price of other readymade edible items which can be made available in the cafeteria. The quoted price of such items cannot be more than the MRP printed on the item.**
- Any relevant information or document which Applicant(s) may consider appropriate for a cafeteria of IGIMS, including documents evidencing their expertise/experience/ideas related to regional Indian cuisines and their contemporary interpretation, other than for which Tender has been invited by IGIMS.
- The rate should be clearly indicated in words and figures. Whenever there is discrepancy between words and figures, the lower among them shall apply.

VIII There should not be any over-writing/cutting in the rates tendered. Any term and condition other than those mentioned in this document shall not be considered and shall be rejected forthwith.

IX. Amendment of Tender Documents.

At any time prior to the deadline for submission of documents, the Chairman may amend the Corrigendum, amendment and addendum tender documents by issuing Corrigendum, amendment and addendum. Any Corrigendum, amendment and addendum issued shall form part of the tender documents and the same may be obtained from the office of Director, IGIMS during office hours.

X. Cost of Application

The Applicant shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of

Tender. IGIMS shall not be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the outcome of the tendering process. The application should also be accompanied by a demand draft of Rs. 5000/- (Five thousand) only drawn in favour of “Director, Indira Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Patna” in State Bank of India as a cost of tender documents.

XI. Language of Applications

All correspondence and documents relating to the Tender shall be written in English/Hindi. Supporting documents and printed literature that are part of the application may be in another language provided they are accompanied by an accurate translation of the relevant passages in English, in which cases, for purpose of interpretation of the tender, the translation shall be considered.

XII. Last Date

The last date and time for receipt of Tender shall be up to 3:30 pm on 02/04/2018 from the publication of the notice. The Tenders received after the stipulated date and time will not be considered and rejected summarily.

IGIMS will not accept any responsibility or grant any relaxation of time for any postal delay in the submission of tender.

XIII. Opening of Tender and Evaluation thereof

- The Tenders received will be opened by a Committee on 04/04/2018 at 4:00 pm.
- The bidders or their authorized representatives should be present at the time of opening of the tender. In case of absence of any bidder during the opening of the tender, no claim of any sort will be entertained.
- Tenders in unsealed condition or without the required documentation and certification are liable to be rejected summarily. Tenders not conforming to the requirements mentioned in the Terms and Conditions above or not accompanied by Earnest Money Deposit are liable to be summarily rejected.
- Before finalizing the list of qualified Bidders, the Committee may arrange to inspect the existing restaurants / establishment or logistics available of the Applicants.
- Thereafter, the tenders shall be evaluated and a list of qualified Applicants will be prepared by the Committee.
- The decision shall be taken based on the credentials, technical qualifications and the price bid, taken together. The decision of the Canteen Committee, IGIMS shall be final and binding on all Applicants.

XIV. False Information

- In the event of false, misleading or wrong information furnished by the Applicant, the Earnest Money Deposit in respect of such Applicants shall be forfeited. Further, during the performance of the contract if it is detected that the contract has been obtained by furnishing false, misleading or wrong information in the Tender, the contract is liable to be terminated and performance, security and other payments due to IGIMS shall be forfeited and the agency is liable to be blacklisted for a period up to three years.

- If the successful Applicant fails to sign the License Agreement within stipulated time or after signing the contract fails to perform any contractual obligation, his/her Earnest Money Deposit shall be forfeited. Depending upon the gravity of violation/omission, the applicant is liable to be blacklisted for a period up to 3 years, without prejudice to any other remedy that the Committee may have under existing law.

XV. Acceptance and Withdrawal

-The decision to accept any Tender shall entirely rest with the Director, IGIMS, Patna, who reserves the right to accept or reject any or all Tenders without assigning any reason whatsoever. There is no obligation on the part of the Chairman to communicate in any way with rejected Applicants. After acceptance of the Tender by Chairman, the Applicant shall have no right to withdraw his Tender or claim higher price. Tender with incomplete information is liable for rejection.

- If any Applicant does not accept any of these conditions, his/her Tender shall not be considered.

XVI. License Agreement

- The successful Applicant(s) (hereinafter referred to as Licensee) shall execute an agreement for the fulfilment of the contract on Rs. 100/- non-judicial stamp paper within 7 (seven) days from the date of acceptance of the Tender. The Agreement shall clearly specify the rights and obligations of the Licensee and IGIMS with respect to the running of the Cafeteria.

- The incidental expenses of execution of License Agreement shall be borne by the Licensee.

- The Licensee shall furnish an unconditional and irrevocable Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) in the format prescribed , in favour of Director, Indira Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Patna for an amount equal to 1 (one) year's rent of the premises for due performance by Licensee of the Terms and Conditions of the License Agreement.

XVII. Security Deposit

- The Licensee shall deposit to IGIMS an additional sum equivalent to a two months rent only as "**Security Deposit**" for the due and complete performance of the provision of these Terms and Conditions and the License Agreement. No interest will be paid on the deposit for the entire period the Licensor retains it. This deposit is refundable subject to adjustments at the time of normal expiry of the term of the Contract.

XVIII. Compliance

- The Licensee shall abide by all rules and regulations, by-laws and guidelines that IGIMS may, from time to time, make or adopt or amend for the care, protection and administration of IGIMS and the general welfare and comfort of its students, Faculties and staff and patient's attendant.
- The Licensee and its employees and agents shall be bound to comply with any instructions issued by IGIMS authority from time to time.
- The Licensee will, during the continuance of this agreement, insure against any claim for workmen's compensation or otherwise of all persons employed by him in connection with his business.
- The Licensee will ensure full fire safety precaution as per rules of Bihar Government.

XIX. Control and Supervision

- The overall control and superintendence of the said licensed premises shall remain vested with IGIMS Authority, whose officers and agents shall at all times have the absolute right of entry into the said premises and be entitled to inspect the Cafeteria premises for its bonafide use, its state of repairs and compliance with the terms and conditions of the License Agreement, without disruption of the normal functioning of the cafeteria. Any change in price of the items due to escalation of price of essential commodities is negotiable and can be done only on prior approval of the IGIMS authority.
- The Licensee shall deposit duplicate keys of the premises with IGIMS whenever it is so demanded and permit IGIMS to make use of the keys during any emergency. The Licensee shall not remove or replace the lock on any door or change the locking device on any door of the licensed premises.
- The Licensee shall maintain a complaint book at a prominent place in the premises and in such a way that it is easily accessible to any person who wishes to record any complaint and the said book shall be open for inspection by the concerned officer of IGIMS. Complaint by e-mail will be treated as official.

XX. Additions and Alterations

No addition/alteration at the Licensed Premises may be undertaken without the prior approval of IGIMS Authority. Layout and design of any proposed addition/alteration shall require prior written approval of IGIMS.

XXI. Maintenance

- The Licensee will keep and maintain the Licensed Premises and the area in and around the Licensed Premises in a clean, hygienic, proper and decent condition; and shall not suffer the premises to be held in a bad state of repair and outlook during the currency of the License Agreement. Further, the Licensee shall not in any manner damage the wall, floor or other structure of the building, nor shall it cause any kind of hindrance or obstruction in the use thereof by IGIMS in any manner whatsoever.
- If the Licensed Premises are not maintained in clean condition by the Licensee, IGIMS shall have powers to get the premises cleaned at the risk and cost of the Licensee and recover liquidated damages at the rate of Rs. 100/-per day for each default up to 7 days and thereafter Rs. 200/- per day and can take other actions including termination of the license.
- In the event of any damages being caused to the Licensed Premises, intentionally or otherwise, by the Licensee, or his/her/its employees or invitees or customers, IGIMS shall be entitled to repair the damage or make the requisite replacement and call upon the Licensee to reimburse the cost thereof, which the Licensee undertakes to pay forthwith on demand.
- The Licensee shall not store or bring or keep in the premises heavy articles so as to injure or damage the licensed premises or keep goods of combustible or inflammable nature, except as reasonably required by the Licensee for performing services under the License Agreement.
- The Licensee shall not keep any forbidden items as notified by the Excise department of Govt. of Bihar.

XXII. Employees

- The Licensee shall employ only such employees who are experienced. The Licensee will ensure that the staff engaged shall observe highest standards of courtesy, manners and professionalism while dealing with visitors and customers of the cafeteria at IGIMS. There should be proper dress code for employee and all hygienic precaution to be taken.
- The Licensee shall employ only such staff as shall have good character and be well behaved and skilful in their business. IGIMS shall be at liberty to forbid the employment of any person whom it may consider undesirable. The staff employed shall conform to such direction as may be issued by IGIMS in respect of time, stay and the points or routes of entry to and exit from the premises and in respect of the use of toilets and washrooms. The cafeteria manager shall also have the character of all persons employed by him verified by the police to the satisfaction of IGIMS before the employment.
- The Licensee shall immediately remove any employee from the Licensed Premises if any employee misbehaves, causes nuisance, or is considered to be undesirable by IGIMS representative. IGIMS shall be at liberty to request the Licensee to replace or change any employee or other staff within 48 hours time, if so needed, upon which request Licensee shall forthwith replace such employee or staff.

XXIII. Compensation or Concession

- The Licensee will not be entitled to any compensation or concession in payment of the License Fee due to addition of any activity in the Licensed Premises by or on behalf of IGIMS or closure of any activity in IGIMS.
- For breach of any Terms and Conditions of the License, IGIMS reserves its right to either terminate the License, or recover compensation from the Licensee for the damage suffered on breach [up to the limit of the security deposit deposited by the Licensee].

XXIV. Duration, Termination and Renewal

- The duration of the License shall be initially for period of 6 Months renewable every year thereafter subject to satisfactory performance.
- IGIMS shall have the right to terminate the License by giving 90 days notice in writing without assigning any reason therefore, at any time.
- The Licensee may also terminate the License by giving 90 days notice in writing.
- IGIMS will be entitled automatically to terminate this Agreement on the occurrence of any of the following events:
 - The Licensee is in breach of its responsibilities and obligations under this Agreement and these have not been rectified after having been given 15 days written notice by IGIMS;
 - The Licensee has a winding up or administration order made in relation to it;
 - if the reputation of IGIMS is damaged on account of Licensee's dealings with third parties.
- In the event of termination of License as provided hereinabove, IGIMS shall always be entitled to and shall have power at its absolute discretion to reoccupy forthwith the Licensed Premises, without notice and without subjecting itself to any liability on that account and notwithstanding any intermediate negotiations or waiver of breach thereof.
- On expiry of the License period or on termination of the License by IGIMS on account of any breach on the part of the Licensee, the Licensee shall deliver the possession of the Licensed Premises in good condition and in peaceful manner along with furniture, fittings, equipment and installations provided by IGIMS. Further, Licensee shall remove his/their goods and other materials within 3 days from the premises, failing which IGIMS reserves its right to remove such goods/materials at the cost and risk of the Licensee and demand payment for such removal. If such payment is not made within 10 (ten) days, IGIMS shall be at liberty to dispose off the goods/materials of the Licensee by public auction to recover the cost. The Licensee shall not be entitled to raise any objection in such an eventuality.
- In the event of any default, failure, negligence or breach, in the opinion of IGIMS, on the part of the Licensee, in complying with all or any of the conditions of the License, IGIMS will be entitled and be at liberty to terminate the license forthwith and resume possession of the Licensed Premises without payment of any compensation or damages and also claim in full or in part the amount deposited by the Licensee for due performance of the Agreement.

XXV. Insurance

At all times during the currency of the License, it shall be the responsibility of the Licensee to obtain insurance coverage in line with standard industry practice, including cover for fire, theft and burglary in respect of all the movable and immovable assets stored or used in the licensed premises and IGIMS shall not be responsible for any loss or damages caused to the Licensee on any account whatsoever.

XXVI. Indemnity

- Licensee shall indemnify IGIMS and hold it harmless from all claims, demands, damages, actions, costs and charges, including against liabilities towards customers or visitors, to which IGIMS may become subject, or which it may have to pay or be held liable for, by reason of any injury to persons, reputation or property suffered or sustained by any agent or employee of IGIMS or arising out of any activity or negligence or omission of the Licensee or its agents or employees while in or about the Licensed Premises or other premises of IGIMS.

- Licensee shall indemnify IGIMS against any loss, claim, costs, damages to, or diminution of, its business and goodwill or any third party claims or proceedings brought against the IGIMS as a result, direct or indirect, of any prejudicial business practice of the Licensee or any misrepresentation of its relationship with the IGIMS. This indemnity shall be without prejudice to any other rights and remedies, which the IGIMS may have under the law.

XXVII. Registration and Permissions

The Licensee shall ensure that all such licenses to be applied for by the Licensee, such as Food Safety and Standards Act 2006, and including GST, are obtained as may be required under the applicable laws, and shall be solely liable for violations and contraventions respecting its business. IGIMS shall in no way be responsible for the non-compliance of any of the laws respecting the business of the Licensee.

XXVIII. Limitation of Liability

- IGIMS shall in no way be liable for any losses or claims arising out of untoward incidents like theft, shoplifting, fire, riots, floods, natural calamities etc.

- In case the Licensee suffers any loss on account of it being unable to carry on its business or restrained by IGIMS for contravention of any of the terms and conditions, the Licensee shall have no claim on IGIMS.

XXIX. Miscellaneous and General Terms for Rendering of Services in Operating Cafeteria

- The Licensee shall be responsible for procuring and arranging all consumables for its use in relation to operation of the Cafeteria.

- Food prepared by the Licensee shall be made under good hygienic conditions, and the standard of hygiene shall be strictly maintained. This will be inspected and ascertained by a Committee, appointed by IGIMS, whose directions will be binding on the Licensee. The foods shall be fresh, wholesome and of good quality. Licensee shall abide by all applicable laws relating to sale of food, hygiene, and safety etc.
- The Licensee shall be fully responsible for the cleanliness of the Cafeteria premises, which must be free of insects, mosquitoes, flies, dust and dirt. The appropriate authority shall inspect the Cafeteria premises periodically, and IGIMS shall have the right to terminate the License Agreement if the premises are found to be in unsanitary condition.
- The Licensee shall not erect or install any temporary structure, or fixture inside the Cafeteria Premises or outside it, without prior written approval of IGIMS.
- The Licensee or any of his/her salespersons shall not sell/consume any hard drinks (such as any alcohol based drinks, and spirits), or narcotic drugs or other prohibited substances within the premises of IGIMS.
- The Licensee shall observe duly at all times the provision of Child Labour (Prohibition and Regulation) Act, 1986 and any other enactment made in this regard.
- The Licensee, for the purpose of fulfilling his obligations, may deploy persons as employees, servers, cooks, etc., who are medically fit with no contagious diseases, who will wear prescribed uniform, who shall have good character and be fit for work in a institutional cafeteria where high quality public service is expected.
- While the existing security personnel of IGIMS shall remain vigil round the clock on campus, the Licensee shall make proper arrangements for the protection of his goods and items from theft/pilferage etc.
- The Licensee shall provide working meal for staff at IGIMS at a rate to be fixed in advance with the approval of IGIMS. The rate for these meals will not be enhanced without the prior approval of IGIMS. A sample menu and price proposed for a simple meal, for an average of 30 persons daily, should be included in the application as specified in Annexure 1.
- The Licensee shall provide meal and refreshments for participants in programmes organized by IGIMS. Rates for these will be fixed in consultation with IGIMS.
- Until execution of the License Agreement, the Terms and Conditions mentioned in the Tender documents shall constitute a binding contract between the Licensee and IGIMS.
- The charges for electricity, water and supporting facilities, shall be paid by the Licensee to IGIMS on monthly basis starting from one month after the execution of this agreement as per conditions laid down in previous clauses.
- The Licensee will not be allowed to use the cafeteria premises for parties or occasions other than those that IGIMS may organize.

XXX. Standard Safety Clauses

Licensee shall:

- construct modular kitchen (Inclusive of all fixtures).

- not store combustible material for a period except as may be necessary for the delivery of contracted services.
- install, at his own cost, an adequate number of Fire Extinguishers [of weight/capacity as per standard norms] and ensure that they are in fully functional condition at all times.

XXXI. Standard Health Clauses

- The Licensed premises, structures and installations thereon, shall be kept in clean and sanitary condition by the Licensee to the satisfaction of IGIMS.
- The officer authorized by IGIMS may, without notice, enter the premises at any time and inspect the premises, material instruments and implements etc., used by the Licensee.
- All instructions given by the officer authorized or nominated by IGIMS or any person working under him to prevent spread of infectious diseases, control and prevention of nuisance from insects, rodents or any other source, shall be carried out by the Licensee and his agents or staff.

XXXII. Clarifications, Disputes and Settlements

That in case of any dispute arising between IGIMS and the Licensee, in respect of the interpretation, conduct or performance of any terms or conditions of these presents, the same shall be referred to the sole arbitration of a person who may be appointed by IGIMS for the purpose, under the provisions of Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996, as amended from time to time. It will be no bar that Arbitrator appointed as aforesaid is or has been an employee of IGIMS and the award of the arbitration will not be challenged or be open to question in any court of law on this account.

XXXIII. Jurisdiction

In case of any dispute where legal action is compelled to be initiated by any of the parties, jurisdiction of the courts shall be Patna judicial jurisdiction.

XXXIV. Force Majeure

- Neither party shall be deemed to be in breach of this agreement if failure to comply with the requirement of this agreement is due to circumstances beyond the control of IGIMS or Licensee.
- If because of any strike or lockout either in IGIMS or in the Local area, the Licensee is unable to function or his business is affected, IGIMS shall not be liable for any loss, which the Licensee may suffer in such an event.

XXXV. Notices

Any notice which is required to be given either by the Licensee or IGIMS, will be in writing, and will be sent to the address as the recipient may designate by notice at the address provided in the License Agreement.

XXVII. Transferability, Assignment and Sub-Contracting

The Licensee shall not have the right to transfer the benefit of this License Agreement or to delegate any obligations to a third party without the prior written consent of IGIMS. The Licensee shall not, unless with the written consent of IGIMS, create a sub-contract of any description with regard to this License or any part thereof, nor shall he without such written consent as aforesaid, assign or transfer his license or any part thereof.

I agree with the terms and conditions mentioned above, and undertake to comply with these at all times during the subsistence of the license granted to me to operate the Cafeteria at Indira Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Sheikhpura, Patna.
