ADMISSION NOTICE FOR M.Sc. (NURSING) COURSE

Applications are invited from eligible candidates for the Admission to Academic Session 2021 for the **M.Sc. (NURSING) COURSE for Ten (10) Seats (Child Health (Paediatric) Nursing – 5, Obstetric & Gynecological Nursing – 05).**

- **Reservation rules as per currently existing Govt. of Bihar. Candidates domiciled outside the state will be considered under unreserved category.**
- **Duration of Course : 02 years**
- **Eligibility Criteria :**

1. The candidate should be a Registered Nurse and Registered Midwife or equivalent with any State Nursing Registration Council.
2. Passed B.Sc. Nursing/B.Sc. Hons. Nursing/Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing with minimum of 55% aggregate marks from an institution which is recognized by Indian Nursing Council.
3. Minimum one year of work experience after Basic B.Sc. Nursing/ B.Sc. Nursing (Hons) from the date of registration as an RNRN.
4. Minimum one year of work experience prior or after Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing from the date of registration as an RNRN.

Syllabus for Entrance Exam: Questions based on B.Sc. Nursing/ B.Sc. Hons. Nursing/Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing subjects as per syllabus of Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi.

➤ **Criteria for Selection :**

- i. Merit list to be prepared based on performance in written entrance examination.
- ii. Duration of Examination: 100 Minutes
- iii. Medium / Language of examination: English

❖ **Method of Selection:** There will be 100 (hundred) Multiple Choice Questions. Each question will carry equal marks and there will be no negative marking. In case of two or more candidates securing equal marks, inter-se-merit will be determined in order of candidates older in age. The result will be published on the notice board / website of the Institute only. The successful candidates will have to report for counseling on the date announced on website. No any further communication will be given by Post/E-mail/Message. Successful candidates will have to undergo medical checkup by the medical board of Institute only before the admission. Medically fit candidates will be finally admitted for the course.

- iv. The minimum cut off marks for qualifying the entrance examination will be –

Open and OBC - 55 percentile

SC/ST - 50 percentile

❖ **In Service candidates:** Submission of No Objection Certificate (NOC) along with the application form, from the current employer is essential.

1. INTRODUCTION:

Indira Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Sheikhpura, Patna – 800 014 is an autonomous super specialty Institute of the State of Bihar – established by the Act of State legislature vide IGIMS Act. 1984. Various facilities are available at this Institute to cater to the needs of patients belonging to the State of Bihar and neighboring states. It is situated at Sheikhpura on Bailey Road, Patna, having sprawling 130 acres campus in the heart of city. Patna Junction Railway Station, Bus Stand & Air Port is located within 6 kilometers of the Institute.

Indira Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Sheikhpura, Patna is a tertiary care super specialty hospital, providing clinical services, training, research and various educational programme of highest standard. School of Nursing was started with GNM Course in 1986 with annual intake of 20 seats and College of Nursing has been started in 2011 with B.Sc. (N) Course on 40 seats. P.B.B.Sc. Nursing started in 2017 with an annual capacity of 20 seats. At present the IGIMS- College of Nursing is running B.Sc. Nursing course -50 seats, P.B. B.Sc. Nursing course -40 seats and GNM course -50 seats.

2. AIMS & OBJECTIVES OF THE INSTITUTE:

1. To develop an apex centre for delivery of health and medical care of highest standard;
2. To train specialists of high order in different branches of nursing services;
3. To improve the health services, in the State through appropriate linkages and referral system with Medical Colleges and District and Sub divisional hospitals;
4. To provide continued education programs and award Diplomas, Degrees and Postgraduate Degrees.
5. To develop clinical research centre for conducting investigation on the problems of human health and diseases peculiar to and prevalent in this part of the country;
6. To develop Community Health Research Center to study and find out solutions to the health problems of the community.
7. To prepare the Nursing researchers to find the solutions relevant to the problems and needs of the Community”.

3. AFFILIATION: The M.Sc. Nursing course is affiliated to INC, New Delhi and Bihar Nurses Registration Council, Patna for session 2021.

4. COURSE AND NUMBER OF SEATS

The Institute will conduct Entrance Examination for admission to M. Sc. Nursing Course being offered at the Institute. Duration of the course and total number of seats available are appended below:-

SYLLABUS AND EXAMINATION: For ‘syllabus and examination rules & regulations’ Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi will be followed strictly. Any amendment in the rules and regulations by the INC for the “syllabus and examination” will be applicable accordingly.

5. **RESERVATION:** Reservation will be as per Bihar Government Reservation Rules. If requisite number of suitable candidates is not available to fill up the seats reserved for the Scheduled Castes, the same will be filled by candidates belonging to the Scheduled Tribes and vice-versa. In case suitable candidates are not available from the two reserved categories, the vacant seats will be filled up by the candidates from the MBC/OBC category. In case suitable candidates are also not available in the MBC/OBC reserved category, the same will be filled up by the candidates from the general category.

6. **ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:-**

1. The candidate should be a Registered Nurse and Registered Midwife or equivalent with any State Nursing Registration Council.
2. Passed B.Sc. Nursing/B.Sc. Hons. Nursing/Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing with minimum of 55% aggregate marks from an institution which is recognized by Indian Nursing Council.
3. Minimum one year of work experience after Basic B.Sc. Nursing/ B.Sc. Nursing (Hons) from the date of registration as an RNRM.
4. Minimum one year of work experience prior or after Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing from the date of registration as an RNRM.

7. **HOW TO APPLY**

Candidates have to download the Application Form from Institute website for the session 2021. Candidate shall have to attach a Demand Draft of Rs. 1000/- (Rs. 500/- for SC/ST) in favour of 'Director, IGIMS, Patna' payable at Patna as cost of examination, otherwise the application shall be considered in-complete and will be rejected. Application received with incomplete information shall be rejected.

- a. The Application Form should be duly filled in by the applicant in his/her own handwriting and sent to the office of **Dean (Academic), Indira Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Sheikhpura, Patna – 800 014** by Registered/Speed Post / Courier.

6.1 **PHOTOGRAPH:-**

- i Four recent coloured passport size photographs are required. Self attested photograph to be affixed on the Application Form, Admit Card etc.

6.3 All certificates in original need to be produced during counseling. **In case of wrong information filled in Application Form their claim to the seat will be rejected / forfeited.**

7. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- i. Incomplete applications and those received late will be rejected and no correspondence would be entertained in this regard. Candidates are advised to dispatch the filled up application form well in advance to ensure that filled up form reaches in time. Applications received after due date shall be summarily rejected. Postal delay shall not be ground for consideration of applications received after due date.
- ii. The list of eligible candidate will be displayed on Institute Notice Board/Institute website before the date of examination.
- iii. The result of selected candidates shall be published on Notice Board/Website of the Institute. **There is no provision for re-evaluation of answer sheets.**
- iv. Original certificate **SHOULD NOT** be sent with the application. They should be produced as and when asked by the Institute.
- v. Candidates should note that only the date of birth as recorded in the Matriculation Certificate/Higher Secondary Examination or an Equivalent Certificate on the date of submission of application will be accepted by the Institute and no subsequent request for its change will be considered or granted.
- vi. Candidates are warned that they should not furnish any particulars that are false or suppress any information in filling up the application form. Candidates are also warned that they should in no case correct or alter or otherwise tamper with any entry in a document or it is attested/certificate copy submitted by them nor should they submit a tampered/ fabricated document.
- vii. If the candidates are called for counseling, it does not mean that candidates will be admitted to the course.
- viii. The candidate allotted the course/seat during the counseling if does not report within the stipulated period after counseling, the registration will be cancelled automatically and the seat will be allotted to the next candidate in second counseling from the waiting list.

8. PENALTY on leaving M.Sc. (Nursing) course before completion:-

After closure of admission process in a particular course for particular session tuition fee and other required fee will not be refunded. Candidate leaving the course before completion will have to pay fee for remaining duration of the course and a penalty of Rs. 25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand only).

Original certificate deposited at the time of admission will be returned only after deposition of fee and penalty.

9. RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- 9.1 All students admitted in the Institute shall maintain good conduct, attend classes regularly and abide by the rules and regulations of the institute in-force from time to time, failing which, their names are liable to be struck off from the rolls of the Institute.
- 9.2 The students shall not leave their duty/class without permission of the HOD/Officer in Charge/Faculty of the department.
- 9.3 Visitors are not allowed during the study hours.
- 9.4 During the course students are expected to carry out works assigned to them.
- 9.5 They should observe personal cleanliness.
- 9.6 Candidates are also instructed to bear Identity Card issued by the Institute during the Hospital hours/while on duty/ in class.
- 9.7 Candidates are required to get registration number from the Indira Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Patna after paying requisite fee within three months of admission. Beyond 3 months the candidates will have to pay late fee. A candidate without registration will not be allowed to take any University Examination (Internal/External)
- 9.8 Admitted Students have to wear white Apron with full sleeves during the Hospital hours/while on duty at their own cost.
- 9.9 a. Student must obtain 80% attendance (irrespective of the kind of absence) in each subject (theory & practical separately) to be eligible for university examination. 100% attendance in each of the practical areas is must before award of degree as per INC norms.
b. Student not fulfilling the minimum attendance required (as prescribed by the Institute from time to time) shall be liable for retention.
c. Student detained in the class on account of failure in examination or due to lack of attendance will be required to pay fee for the additional year before they are allowed to continue in the course.
- 9.10 No student will be allowed to join any other course during the period of the course to which he/she is admitted.
- 9.11 Selected Student will be required to submit all original certificates (including caste certificate), which shall be retained by the Institute during the period of the course he/she is admitted.
- 9.12 The Certificates can be given to the students only after he/she quits the course or after completion of the course, once he/she submits the No-Dues certificate.
- 9.13 During admission the Guardian should sign in a consent form for any emergency operation/treatment.
- 9.14 Uniform for clinical duty – for girls - white salwar, kurta, -white apron (full sleeves) & white shoes and for boys - white formal trouser, shirt, white apron (full sleeves) & white shoes. Navy blue blazer in winter.

10. CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS AT IGIMS, SHEIKHPURA, PATNA

(i) Maintenance of Discipline among students of the IGIMS:

- 10.1 All powers relating to discipline and disciplinary action are vested with the Director, IGIMS.
- 10.2 The Director may delegate all such powers, as he/she deems proper to the Dean and to such other persons as he/she may specify on his behalf.
- 10.3 Without prejudice to the generality of power to enforce discipline under the Rules. The following shall amount to acts of gross indiscipline:
- 10.4 Physical assault or threat to use physical force against any member of the teaching or non-teaching staff of any Department/Centre of IGIMS or any other persons within the premises/Campus of IGIMS.
- 10.5 Carrying or use or threat of use of any weapon.
- 10.6 Violation of the status, dignity and honor of students belonging to the Scheduled Casts, Scheduled Tribes and other Backward castes.
- 10.7 Any practice, whether verbal or otherwise, derogatory to women.
- 10.8 Any attempt at bribing or corruption in any manner.
- 10.9 Willful destruction of Institutional property.
- 10.10 Creating ill-will or intolerance on religious or communal grounds.
- 10.11 Causing disruption in any manner of the functioning of the IGIMS, Sheikhpura, Patna.

(ii) Regarding ragging the directive of Supreme Court will be followed strictly. It is as under:

“As per direction of the Hon’ble Supreme Court of India, the Government has banned ragging completely in any form inside and outside of the campus and the Institute authorities are determined not to allow any form of ragging.

Whoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in abets or instigates ragging within or outside any educational Institution, shall be suspended, expelled or rusticated from the Institution and shall also be liable to fine which may extend to Rs. 10,000/-. The punishment may also include cancellation of admission suspension from attending the classes, withholding/withdrawing fellowship/scholarship/sponsorship and other financial benefits, with holding or canceling the result. The decision shall be taken by the Head of the Institution”.

- 11.1 Without prejudice to the generality of his/her powers relating to the maintenance of discipline and taking such action in the interest of maintaining discipline as may seem to him/her appropriate. The Director, may in exercise of his/her powers aforesaid order or direct that any student or students:
- 11.2 Be expelled;
- 11.3 Be, for a stated period: be not for a stated period, admitted to a course or courses of study in IGIMS.
- 11.4 Be fined with a sum of rupees that may be specified;
- 11.5 Be debarred from taking any examination(s) for one or more semesters.
- 11.6 Withhold the result of the student(s) concerned in the Examination(s) in which he/she or they have appeared be cancelled.
- 11.7 Be prohibited for appearing or completing any examination for any unfair means like copying taking notes, mobiles or any other electronic gadgets inside the examination hall.
- 11.8 At the time of admission, every student shall be required to sign a declaration that on admission he/she submits himself/herself to the disciplinary jurisdiction of the Director and several authorities of the IGIMS who may be vested with the authority to exercise discipline under the Acts, the Statutes, the Rules and the rules that have been framed there under by competent authorities of IGIMS.

(iii) Prohibition of and Punishment for Ragging:-

1. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited, within the premises of College/Department of Institution and any part of IGIMS and also outside the IGIMS campus.
2. Any individual or collective act or practice or ragging constitute gross indiscipline shall be dealt with under this rules.
3. Ragging for the Purposes of this rules, ordinarily means any act, conduct or practice by which dominant power or status of senior students is brought to bear on students freshly enrolled or students who are, in any way, considered junior or inferior by other students and includes individual or collective acts or practice which:
 - a. Involve physical assault or threat or use of physical force;
 - b. Violate the status, dignity and honour of women students;
 - c. Violate the status; dignity and honour of students belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward castes.
 - d. Expose students to ridicule and contempt and affect their self-esteem;
 - e. Entail verbal abuse and aggression, indecent gesture and absence behavior.
4. The Director, Dean, Hostel Superintendent and Faculty of IGIMS shall take immediate action on any information of the occurrence of ragging.
5. Notwithstanding anything in Clause (4) above, the Dean or any other Faculty member/or authority may also suo moto enquire into any incident of ragging and make a report to the Director of the identity of those who have engaged and the nature of the incident.
6. The Dean may also submit an initial report establishing the identity of the perpetrators of ragging and the nature of the ragging incident.
7. On the receipt of a report under clause (5) or (6) or a determination by the relevant authority disclosing the occurrence or ragging incidents described in the Clause 3(a), (b) and (c) the Director shall direct or order rustication of a student or students for a specific number of semester.
8. The Director may in other cases of ragging order or direct that any student or students be expelled or be not, for a stated period, admitted to a course of study as IGIMS, departmental examination for one or more semesters or that the result of the student or students concerned in the examination(s) in which they appeared be cancelled.
9. In case where students who have obtained degree(s) of IGIMS are found guilty under this Rules, appropriate action will be taken for withdrawal of degrees conferred by the IGIMS.
10. For the Purpose of this Rules, abetment to ragging will also amount to ragging.

(iv) Anti Sexual Harassment Monitoring Committee:-

A statutory committee, comprising of members from the teaching and non-teaching staff as well as students looks into matters related to sexual harassment of students and staff in the college. Any person aggrieved in this matter may fearlessly approach the committee for a fair and concerned hearing and redressal.

(v) Unauthorized Absence of Students:-

Unauthorized 15 days absence of student will be informed to the Student and also Parents or Local Guardians. At least 3 reminders will be issued with a gap of 10 days by the Academic Section to these students. Thereafter the action of cancellation of the registration of the concerned will be decided by the Dean/Director, IGIMS.

(v) Undertaking:-

All the candidates admitted to the course shall have to give an undertaking at the time of admission that he/she has not been involved in any kind of criminal and unlawful activities in the past.

10.1 Examination fee will be charged extra as per university rules.

10.2 ID card Rs.100/-

10.3 Candidates selected for admission shall have to pay the fees etc. prescribed for the course within prescribed time after the announcement of the list of selected candidates, failing which his/her admission shall be cancelled and the next candidate on the waiting list shall be admitted in his/her place.

10.4 The fees and other charges once paid shall not be refunded, if a student leaves the Institute/course for any reason. Once the admission process is complete for that session any student leaving course before completion will have to pay tuition fee and required fee for the remaining course and penalty Rs.25,000/-(Twenty Five Thousand only). His/her caution money & certificate will be refunded only after that.

10.5 No correspondence in this regard shall be entertained. However, Caution Money submitted by the candidate shall be refunded on submission of 'No Dues Certificate' after completion of course/ quitting from the course.

10. LEGAL JURISDICTION

Any Litigation regarding course/ admission test of Indira Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Sheikhpura, Patna will come under the Jurisdiction of Patna only.

11. COMMON MISTAKES LEADING TO REJECTION OF APPLICATION:

- 11.1 Application not submitted on application forms issued by the Institute/downloaded from institute's website (along with bank draft of required amount) for the current academic session.
- 11.2 Variation in name spelling as recorded in application, SSC or equivalent certificates. Variation (if any) should be supported by an affidavit on stamp paper duly attested by a Notary.
- 11.3 Application received after due date.
- 11.4 Incomplete application form in any respect, e.g. photograph not pasted; photograph without name and date; column or items not complete.
- 11.5 Photographs submitted are not identical or snapped before date of publication of Advertisement or pasted without including name and date.
- 11.6 Affidavit that the student is not pursuing any other course in any other University at the time of Admission.
